COMPENSATION FUNDS OF TWO MILLION BRITISH POUNDS STERLING

We wish to notify you as a beneficiary in compensation of £2,000,000.00 (Two Million Pounds Sterling). We, the authorized governing body of the United Nations monetary unit has been authorized to investigate the unnecessary delay on your payment, recommended and approved in your favour by United Nations Security Council.

During the course of our investigation, it was discovered with dismay that your payment has been unnecessarily delayed by corrupt officials of the previously appointed paying bank who were making efforts to divert allocated funds into their private bank accounts. To prevent this, security of your funds have been organized in the form of a bank ATM card with a Personal Identification Number (PIN). This will enable only you to have direct access and control over your funds with the Bank ATM CARD. We will monitor your compensation payment by ourselves to avoid any repetition of the hopeless situation created by the officials of the previous paying banks. An irrevocable payment guarantee has been issued by the World Bank Group and the International Monetary Fund (IMF) for your payment.

The United Nations Compensation Commission (UNCC) was created in 1991 as a subsidiary organ of the United Nations Security Council under Security Council resolution 687 (1991) to process claims and pay compensation for losses and damages suffered as a direct result of Iraq's unlawful invasion and occupation of Kuwait in 1990-91. Hitherto, the United Nations Compensation Commission have received all the overdue outstanding payments owed to the following: firms, contractors, inheritance, next-of-kin, super hurricane Sandy and lottery beneficiaries that originated from Africa, Europe, Americas, Asia including the Middle East. Your payment has been approved to be credited in your favour through bank ATM VISA/MasterCARD which will be sent to you by courier delivery service. Your email address was randomly selected from Kuwait and USA databases which qualifies you to lodge your claim for payment of £2,000,000.00. that your case Reference Number: UNCCORG/08469IMF for your payment falls under the UK-Afro-Euro-Asia geographic payment zoning (PCZA1). Therefore your payment, when processed under the PCZA1 geographic payment zoning, will be executed by a treasury allocation of funds to any of our two PCZA1 appointed paying bank in United Kingdom or South Africa. Your money will be loaded and paid out to you in an Automated Teller Machine (ATM) VISA/MasterCARD by the PCZA1 appointed paying bank in United Kingdom or South Africa.

You are advised to contact the UNCC Claims Manager immediately you receive this notice to file for your funds' claim and payment through delivery of an ATM VISA/MasterCARD. Your payment by ATM VISA/MasterCARD will enable you withdraw your funds from any bank ATM in your country or any other part of the world, but the default maximum withdrawal amount allowed per day on the card is £5000.
